Comments from the 2009 Amherst Antiques on the Green Show

**Welcome** to the 15<sup>th</sup> Annual Fall Antique Show presented by the Historical Society of Amherst, NH. The show will be Sat., September 18, 2010 on the historic Village Green. This is a **rain or shine** event. Improved hours will be **9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**

The Historical Society advertises this show in local and out-of-town newspapers, antique trade papers, and in magazine calendars. Posters will be distributed as well as hand-out advertising cards. Additionally, the members of the Historical Society are given free admittance to the show. This year's Antiques on the Green takes place during a historical and commemorative time for the town of Amherst. In January, Amherst and her citizens kicked off a year of town wide celebrations to mark the 250<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the town's first charter officially signed on January 18, 1760 between Governor Benning Wentworth and King George II. Amherst residents look forward to a plentitude of activities this spring, summer and fall. Well known speakers, a formal gala, Village walking tours, a craft fair, and historic house tours are some of the events already on the calendar. We are confident that the newly generated "buzz" around town will only enhance the visibility of our special antiques show and encourage many repeat visitors as well as first timers to explore the wonderful world of antiques.

The renting of space on the Green is on a first come basis. There is room for approximately 50 dealers. On attached paper is the contract for space. Please fill out and return ASAP. (**Check contract for early response deal!**)  
Food Vendors will be improving their offering this year and we are again offering a special box lunch menu for our dealers due to popular demand.

To generate more traffic to the show, an antique verbal appraisal is being planned on the Common for an hour during the show. An entrance fee to the show must be paid to participate in one item being appraised by a local licensed auctioneer professional. Adjacent to the Common is the historic Congregational Church which is the location for the Amherst Town Library book sale held also on September 18<sup>th</sup>.

Dealers agree that the Common is a picturesque and perfect spot to have a successful antique show. Our two museums are within walking distance of the Common and will be open the day of the show. Additionally many local antique shops offer a whole day of antiquing to those traveling to Amherst for the show. If you know a dealer that should participate please pass along this information. We would be delighted to speak with them about joining the show.

Your dealer participation is an important part of our mission. The funds we raise at this event go directly to our college scholarship for an Amherst high school student. As you can imagine, families are relying heavily on any financial assistance they can receive for their son or daughter.
